Autumn 1 2018 Curriculum Statement

Foundation

Subject/Topic	Content
English	We have developed our Phonics Phase 2 sounds with lots of blending and segmenting. We have practised our letter formation for these words and have practised our 'emerging writing' with writing cards to Mr Grinling, a shopping list for sandwiches, a pirate letter and pirate story as well as a cauldron recipe.
Maths	We have been learning our numbers and counting objects to match to numerals as well as counting other objects in our environment. We have also been ordering numbers and writing more/less of sets of objects.
Science	We have been investigating light and dark, playing with torches and changing colours. We have made simple circuits and have also investigated floating and sinking and pulleys as well as looking at the Autumn changes in the environment. We have learnt how to cook soup and make sandwiches.
The Arts	We have been exploring materials independently - junk modelling/painting using a range of resources for own creativity. We have also created Lighthouses and cutting and sticking school shoes. We have enjoyed dressing up and role play as well as our Charanga music activities and singing.
Humanities	We have been talking about 'same' and 'different' linked to lighthouses and thinking about why we have lighthouses. We have also explored Autumn.
Physical Education	We have been developing our understanding of the space around us and working as a team and listening by playing parachute and circle games. We have been learning how to control our body by playing 'stop/go' games and sequencing movements.
RE/PSHCE	We have been exploring 'what makes me special' and our feelings of sad, happy, scared. We have also spent lots of time learning about class rules and friendship.
Whole School/Federation Events	We took part in the Harvest Service at St. James Church and an Autumn walk in the community.
