## Autumn 1 2018 Curriculum Statement

### Year 1 & 2

Subject/Topic	Content
<b>English</b>	We have developed our story writing skills which include using expanded noun phrases. We have retold stories with sequencing and drama and then created our own versions and spent time editing and improving them.
<b>Maths</b>	We have spent time revisiting place value in preparation for our calculation work involving addition and beginning to move on to subtraction. We have developed our number bonds to 10/20/100 and related facts and learnt how to record our work efficiently.
<b>Science</b>	We have investigated light and shadows which has included looking at materials and whether they are opaque, translucent, transparent. We have investigated materials and identified what properties different materials have. We made shadows outside and discussed how they had been created.
<b>The Arts</b>	We have developed our fine motor skills by using cutting and sticking methods to create lighthouses and baskets. We made 'suncatchers' linked with our science work and for music explored 'Cannon'.
<b>Humanities</b>	We have learned about the positioning of lighthouses and the history of lighthouses (how their appearance has changed over time)
<b>Physical Education</b>	We have been developing our throwing and catching skills, working on under arm and over arm throwing and catching.
<b>RE/PSHCE</b>	We have looked at Friendship and the qualities of a good friend.
<b>Whole School/Federation Events</b>	We took part in the Harvest Service at St. James Church and an Autumn walk in the community as well as a joint Poetry Day,
