Year 1 & 2

Subject/Topic	Content
English	This half term we have been proving that we know how to write a sentence and learning how to 'dig deeper' by adding adjectives into a sentence.
Maths	We have been practising numbers to 100 and number bonds to 10/20. We have also been developing our understanding of fractions and time.
Science	We have been learning about electricity. We have investigated broken circuits to solve the problem of how to fix them. We have also been reading electrical diagrams and drawing our own.
The Arts	Our Key Learning Question has been, 'How do you know the see isn't calm?' We have been learning different techniques to create stormy sea pictures.
Humanities	In Geography we have been learning about features of our environment including man-made and natural features, compass points, and discussing features of the sea side.
Physical Education	We have been developing our ball skills, learning how to control and pass a ball to each other.
