Year 1 & 2

Our over-arching question this term is; "What is the impact of humans on our circle of life"

Subject/Topic	Content
English	<p>This term we will be reading and using: Way Home; The Tin Forest and Messy Magpie to support us in our English work. These texts will provide us with a range of opportunities to write for different purposes, applying our growing knowledge of both fiction and non-fiction writing.</p> <p>This term we will continue to develop writing extended sentences using a wider range of connectives and punctuation.</p>
Maths	<p>This term we will be recapping on our arithmetic skills for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.</p> <p>We will then spend time investigating the properties of 2D and 3D shapes: finding out what they are called, the properties that make them up and sorting them into groups.</p> <p>We will also be looking at handling data by creating tally charts and bar graphs linked to our litter picks.</p>
Science	<p>This theme we will look at the properties of different materials before starting to explore some of the long term impacts of plastic waste on our environment, habitats and life cycles with a particular focus on some of our local habitats including Sugar Mill Ponds.</p>
The Arts	<p>Following a collection of plastic waste we aim to produce some upcycling products alongside our parents as well as producing junk model vehicles.</p> <p>We will explore pastels and how these can be used to shade and create images that show our habitat in different stages.</p>
Humanities	<p>As part of our 'circle of life' project we will look at understanding the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the equator and North and South Pole. We will use world maps, atlas and globes to identify the UK and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans at this key stage. We will use aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features.</p>
Physical Education	<p>As part of Fitness Friday we will be focusing on ball skills as well as working with Hull FC.</p>

<p>RE/PSHCE</p>	<p>As part of wellbeing mornings we will be looking at how we can protect and develop our local environment as well as looking at developing a healthier lifestyle by sampling and making our own healthy snacks. Our key learning question for RE is “How do we keep the world special?”</p>
<p>Computing</p>	<p>This term we will be looking at how we keep ourselves safe on the internet and how important it is to keep our personal information safe.</p>
